Requirements for Contestants:

- *The essay contest is open to senior girls who will be attending college with proof of acceptance.*
- *Essay must be typed (12 point font), double-spaced (MLA) format.*
- *Essays must be between 300 to 500 words.*
- *Each entry submitted must include essay, cover sheet, application and college acceptance letter.*
- *Each high school will submit the names of the winners who will attend the event. One student winner from each school will be selected to win a scholarship.*
- *The winner selected from each school to receive the scholarship **must** attend the luncheon (Date to be announced.)*
- *All attendees will be required to wear appropriate Tea Party attire.*
 - a. *Wear a pretty dress for a feminine look*
 - b. *Wear a sharp suit for an easy, pulled-together look*
 - c. *Choose nice trousers for casual elegance*
 - d. *Pair a skirt with a sweater set for a sweet, classic look*
 - e. *No jeans of any kind, no shorts, or tank tops are appropriate attire for this Tea Party for the Soul.*
